

Air Tightness Testing Course 4 Day ATT Courses based in Liverpool and Ireland (IRE)

Aims and Objectives of Air Tightness Testing Training:

- · Review Building Regulations in regard to ATT
- To understand why permeability testing is a requirement.
- To understand what air leakage is and how is it measured
- Who does this effect?
- What is required and how do you comply?
- · Regulations for testing and reporting.
- Using ATT equipment, structure preparation and reporting results.

Due to changes in the field of Air Tightness Testing and the introduction of new competency schemes, our course structure has been updated to reflect the new National Occupational Standards (NOS).

The first three days of the course will cover NOS ASTATT 1 to 9 documents, and the Minimal Technical Competence (MTC) for a level 1 tester.

The fourth day is an examination day which will divided into 3 separate sections. All 3 must be successfully completed to pass the examination process:

First examination is an open book multiple choice exam covering the theoretical aspects of the Air Tightness Industry.

Second examination is a building envelope area and volume calculation examination using supplied plans.

Third examination is a practical exam where the student is observed carrying out a full Air Tightness Test on a real structure.
